\$48,000 in StellerImpact Grants Awarded to Local Groups in the Kootenay and Boundary regions this Credit Union Day

Cranbrook, BC: October 17th – Eighteen different nonprofit community groups and initiatives in the Kootenay and Boundary regions have been awarded a StellerImpact community grant, ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 – totaling \$48,000.

The grant program, now in its second year, supports community-focused projects in the areas served by StellerVista Credit Union, including Cranbrook, Castlegar, Fernie, Sparwood, Elkford, the Slocan Valley, and the West Boundary..
